Drama activities for reading groups

Teach these activities to the class/groups and then students can use them independently

Hot seating Skits with four words A student takes on the role of one Select 4 challenging words from a text. of the characters Create a short skit based on the story The other students ask questions. and use the four words. Thoughts and questions Actitout A student takes on the role of a character. Select part of the text The other students ask them to share and act it out. thoughts and questions. Call a friend Puppetshow One partner is a character from the text. Create a puppet show to retell a story. Call the character and talk about what happened in the story. Freeze frame Write a play script Create a scene from a story. Write a section of a story as a play One student is the curator and asks the script and then perform the play. characters/objects to talk. Impromptu speech Performance reading Group brainstorms topics from a text Choose a section of text. for impromptu speeches.

Practise reading it aloud. Perform it to your group/class.

Each student takes a turn to present a 30 second speech.
